



WHAT DOES BEING AN EXTERNAL STUDENT OF MMU ENTITLE YOU TO?

External students are students who are registered for an MMU award, but enrolled for their course with one of our partner colleges.

As an external student of MMU you are entitled to:

1. Remote access (e.g. from home or the college at which you are enrolled) to a number of online resources in support of your academic studies only.

2. An external student status ID card

If you plan to visit Manchester during your period of registration you may like to apply for an external student ID card. This card will give you access to MMU Libraries, including external borrowing rights. If so please ask your MDP Programme Manager for more details and the necessary application form.

You are also entitled to an MMU email address and access to MMU WebCT facilities however these are not relevant for the MDP Diploma in Management programme.
